- Fryent Way Car Park in the centre of the Park, west of Fryent Way. TQ 1959 8770. (Meeting point 13).
- Roe Green Walled Garden, Roe Green Park, NW9 9HA: from opposite the junction of Kingsbury Road with Valley Drive (also buses 183 and 204), follow the park road into Roe Green Park, go left at the fork and continue to the Walled Garden. Kingsbury tube station is nearby.

On Stadium Event Days, please be aware of parking restrictions.

Children must be accompanied by an adult.

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Conservation projects

Practical projects offering a choice of conservation work for all. Learn about wildlife and techniques for restoring and creating habitats. We also aim to improve paths and views.

Sunday projects at Fryent Country Park commence with a briefing at 10am. Volunteers should arrive by 0945 at the meeting point ready to move with the tools to the location for that project. If you arrive after 10am look for and follow the yellow 'A' markers to the project site (or walk in increasing concentric circles from the meeting point and find the signs or the project). Tea and coffee are provided. Projects finish at 12.30pm.

Sunday 6 September	Warrens Ponds. We are aiming to complete the overflow pond, with tasks also on nearby hedges and gaps between fields. Meet in the layby opposite Fryent Way Car Park (meeting point 12). Parking in Fryent Way Car Park.
Sunday 13 September	Great Cowlays woodland paths and Long Down Pond. Increasing the light to the pond while it is dry and widen paths in Great Cowlays. Mower if dry. Meet at the entrance to the Country Park on the east side of Fryent Way near to Salmon Street roundabout (meeting point 5).

Sunday 20 September	Barn Hill: The Repton woodland landscaping on the south-east of the summit and view to London; view to Harrow-on-the-Hill and Fishpond edges. Mower if dry. Meet at the turn on Barn Hill (road) near to 81 Barn Hill (meeting point 7).
Sunday 27 September	Preston Eastfield scrub habitat, Gaderbrook and Lower Hydes field gaps. Lyon field and hedge. Mower if dry. Meet at Broadview, near to the junction with Fryent Way NW9. (Meeting point 10).
Sunday 4 October	Cowlays woodland. Working along the brow of Beane Hill, Great Hillcroach and Short Down East. Woodland paths. Mower if dry. Meet at the entrance between 199-219 Salmon Street, opposite Mallard Way, NW9 (meeting point 4).
Sunday 11 October	Barn Hill. The Clump and Bardon Hill Pond area. Opening the view of the west side of The Clump and grassland conservation near to Bardonhill Pond. Mower if dry. Meet at the side road at the junction of Beverley Gardens with Uxendon Hill. (Meeting point 8).
Sunday 18 October	Eldestrete and Hell Lane. Work within this ancient green lane, on the paths between fields; and on the nearby Richards and Honey Slough Ponds. Meet at Fryent Way Car Park (meeting point 13).
Sunday 25 October	Great and Little Hillcroach. Based in Great Hillcroach, the project will work on the surrounds of Little Hillcroach Pond, gaps between fields and on the hedgerows. Meet in the layby opposite Fryent Way Car Park (meeting point 12). Parking in Fryent Way Car Park.
Sunday 1 November	Hedgerows and hedgerow scalloping; and for conservation of Narrow-leaved Bitter-cress. Goldringe hedgerows. hedge 24, Gotfords Pond, and nearby sections of the Mounds Orchard. Meet at the lay-by that is on Fryent Way, approximately sixty metres south of the junction with Valley Drive (meeting point 11).
Sunday 8 November	Woodland edge hedge-laying. Repton woodland belt beyond the southern end of the Poplar avenue. Mower if dry. Meet at the turn on Barn Hill (road) near to 81 Barn Hill (meeting point 7).
Sunday 15 November	Cowlays. Based at The Pightle Orchard and extending also into the woodland paths of Beane Hill. Mower, only if dry. Meet at the entrance between 199-219 Salmon Street, opposite Mallard Way, NW9 (meeting point 4).
Sunday 22 November	Masons Field and Half Yards Meade. A project on the green lanes, paths and conservation of Great Burnet in Half Yards Made. Mower if dry. Meet at the Larkspur Close entrance to the Country Park. (Meeting point 2).
Sunday 29 November	Summers Croft. Woodland paths and conservation hedgelaying. Meet at the turn on Barn Hill (road) near to 81 Barn Hill (meeting point 7).
Sunday 6 December	Bush Farm, conservation hedgelaying, hedgerow scalloping, the Southwell Ponds and field gaps at Homefield North. Meet at Bush Farm (meeting point 3).
Sunday 13 December	Saltcroft Glade and scrub habitats. Scrub with its mix of shrubs, young trees and grasslands is a valuable habitat. Meet at Fryent Way Car Park (meeting point 13).
Sundays 20 & 27 December	No project. No project.
