- Fryent Way Car Park in the centre of the Park, west of Fryent Way. TQ 1959 8770. (Meeting point 13).
- Roe Green Walled Garden, Roe Green Park, NW9 9HA: from opposite the junction of Kingsbury Road with Valley Drive (also buses 183 and 204), follow the park road into Roe Green Park, go left at the fork and continue to the Walled Garden. Kingsbury tube station is nearby.

On Stadium Event Days, please be aware of parking restrictions.

Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Saturday 6 June	Roe Green Walled Garden Open Day. Roe Green Walled Garden, Roe Green Park, Kingsbury NW9 9HA. 11am-4pm.
Butterfly monitoring	April - September: Weekly: The butterfly records contribute to local, London and national knowledge to help the conservation of butterflies. Please enquire.
Frogs and Ponds	In late summer a note is made of whether individual ponds retain water. (Late winter / early spring - count the number of individual clumps of Frogspawn in each pond).
Plant surveys	Project on plants that act as indicator plants for habitats.

Conservation projects

Practical projects offering a choice of conservation work for all. Learn about wildlife and techniques for restoring and creating habitats. We also aim to improve paths and views.

Sunday projects at Fryent Country Park commence with a briefing at 10am. Volunteers should arrive by 0945 at the meeting point ready to move with the tools to the location for that project. If you arrive after 10am look for and follow the yellow 'A' markers to the project site (or walk in increasing concentric circles from the meeting point and find the signs or the project). Tea and coffee are provided. Projects finish at 12.30pm.

Sunday 3 May	Gaderbrook, Preston Eastfield and Lower Hydes. Mound at Richards Pond. Mower if dry. Meet at Broadview, near to the junction with Fryent Way NW9. (Meeting point 10).
Sunday 10 May	Bush Farm Orchard, swale and St Robert Southwell Ponds. Mower if dry. Meet at Bush Farm (meeting point 3).
Sunday 17 May	Barn Hill. Summit area. Mower if dry. Meet at the turn on Barn Hill (road) near to 81 Barn Hill (meeting point 7).
Sunday 24 May	Little Cowlays woodland. Mower if dry. Meet at the entrance between 199-219 Salmon Street, opposite Mallard Way, NW9 (meeting point 4).
Sunday 31 May	Masons Field and Half Yards Meade. Mower if dry. Meet at the Larkspur Close entrance to the Country Park. (Meeting point 2).
Sunday 7 June	Barn Hill. Conveyvale and main path. Mower if dry. Meet at the side road at the junction of Beverley Gardens with Uxendon Hill. (Meeting point 8).
Sunday 14 June	Mounds Orchard; Goldring Field, ponds, paths and seat; to Meade and Warrens. Hay meadow survey if dry (with identification of the larval foodplants of butterflies). Meet in the layby opposite Fryent Way Car Park (meeting point 12). Parking in Fryent Way Car Park.
Sunday 21 June	The Pightle Orchard and Cowlays woodland paths. Hay meadow survey. Mower if dry. Meet at the entrance between 199-219 Salmon Street, opposite Mallard Way, NW9 (meeting point 4).
Sunday 28 June	Masons Field and Hay Meadows survey. Mower if dry. Meet at the Larkspur Close entrance to the Country Park. (Meeting point 2).
Sunday 5 July	Bush Farm Orchard, swale and St Robert Southwell Ponds. Mower if dry. Meet at Bush Farm (meeting point 3).
Sunday 12 July	Barn Hill. Summit area. Mower if dry. Meet at the turn on Barn Hill (road) near to 81 Barn Hill (meeting point 7).
Sunday 19 July	Cowlays woodland. Paths in Great Cowlays from the entrance and the Maze. Mower if dry. Meet at the entrance between 199-219 Salmon Street, opposite Mallard Way, NW9 (meeting point 4).
Sunday 26 July	Dormers Meade Pond to Little Hillcroach Pond and Mounds Orchard. Meet in the layby opposite Fryent Way Car Park (meeting point 12). Parking in Fryent Way Car Park.
Sunday 2 August	Lyon Field meadow, Honey Slough and surrounds of Richards Pond, Preston Eastfield, Gaderbrook stream and Lower Hydes. Mower if dry. Meet at Broadview, near to the junction with Fryent Way NW9. (Meeting point 10).
Sunday 9 August	Barn Hill. Lombardy Poplar avenue and Hedge 36 path. Mower if dry. Meet at the turn on Barn Hill (road) near to 81 Barn Hill (meeting point 7).
Sunday 16 August	Great Hydes, Upper Hydes (and Richards Ponds). Meet at Fryent Way Car Park (meeting point 13).
Sunday 23 August	Little Cowlays woodland. Mower if dry. Meet at the entrance between 199-219 Salmon Street, opposite Mallard Way, NW9 (meeting point 4).
Sunday 30 August	Where conservation is needed most. Project – and meeting place, to be decided nearer to the time. Information will be provided in advance.
